## Prayer Focus: Radio Rhema

part of a letter from Radio Rhema treasurer, Arthur Gilmore:

"We have struggled to find volunteers for the station over the past five years, and not had cash to employ staff. At present, there is just one regular volunteer providing technical services. I have managed the books, there are no regular announcers, and no one reviewing what goes to air. That is all very unsatisfactory for a community radio station.

The Christian Media Hub (CMH) will be contracted by us to perform essential tasks which have been neglected because no one has volunteered to do them.

To cover the cost, the plan is to increase our income by attracting new sponsors and new supporters, rebuilding our program using updated songs including carefully vetted secular songs, hopefully leading to more listeners, including some who do not know Jesus personally.

Under the CMH arrangement, the committee continues to set the policy for broadcasting, and will still be looking for volunteers as announcers, and to perform other tasks, currently neglected. Having announcers behind the microphone, at least for breakfast, morning and afternoon will greatly enhance our listener appeal."
